WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Since last week's report, LCIF raised \$1,893,001. The largest constitutional area increases were in CA IV with an increase of \$645,761, CA V with an increase of \$473,647, CA VI with an increase of \$447,260, and CA VIII with an increase of \$140,002.
- There are 78 new Model Clubs since last week's report. CA VI has 32 new Model Clubs, CA V has 16 new Model Clubs, CA IV has 11 new Model Clubs, CA I has eight new Model Clubs, CA VIII has seven new Model Clubs, and CAs II and VII each have two new Model Clubs.
- There are no new major donors this week. One Lead Donor increased their pledge and is now a Progressive Lead Donor.
